Each and every one of you should be proud of your accomplishments. And we want you all to know we appreciate all you have done to support your clubs and NORTEX.

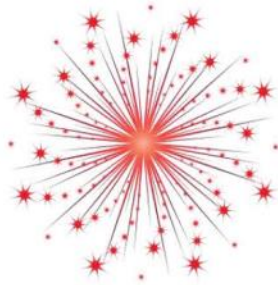

Promenade Home

We can learn some powerful life lessons on a square dance floor. We have to learn to cooperate and coordinate our efforts with seven other people. We have to trust that the caller knows where he's leading us. We must learn to separate his instructions from all the other noise in the room. About the time we get comfortable and think we know what's coming next, we turn around and find ourselves in a completely unexpected and unfamiliar position. But in the end, we can always expect to promenade home.

By the time the caller announces that it's time to promenade home, we've already been through some stuff. Probably a lot of stuff. We've squared through, turned through, and found ourselves on the other side of a right and left through. We've passed through (more times than we can remember) and we've starred through. There's a good chance we were instructed to do an eight chain through—and we did it. Or maybe not.

When the calls are coming rapid fire and there's no time to think; we can only respond based on the teaching, the practice, and the experience we've gathered before we ever walked into the room. There's always the chance that somebody in our square didn't hear a particular call. Or perhaps they didn't see how to execute the call from an unfamiliar position. Or maybe their mind just went blank. (It happens!) And when that happens, the whole square can break down. We've all experienced some pretty complete "train wrecks" on a square dance floor. We stand around in a cloud of dust and wonder "What happened?" And perhaps even "Who did it?" But really, those questions are unimportant. At those times, the important thing is to wait for the call to "promenade home."

This is our chance to join hands with our partner and go back to our starting position. If we've been successful so far, it's a chance to take a breath, smile at someone nearby, and prepare for the next series of calls. The next challenge. We never know what's coming. If, however our latest efforts ended in complete disaster, this is our chance to regroup, re-focus, and yes, prepare for the next series of calls. They just keep coming. Until it's over. But it isn't over yet! We can still salvage something from this dance. We can even still make it fun. Promenade home. And smile!

Sometimes, when I'm standing among the rubble of my most recent real life mess, I can hear the call in the depths of my heart to "promenade home." It's the call to return to that quiet place in the presence of God where my mind can be renewed and my soul can be restored. It's the call to remember my first love and return to the foundation stones of my life. It's the invitation to start fresh. To forget the things that are behind, and to reach forward to the new opportunities God has set before me. The prize and the high calling are still out there. I don't know what's coming next; but I intend to keep dancing—until it's over. And then I'll hear that final call to "promenade home."

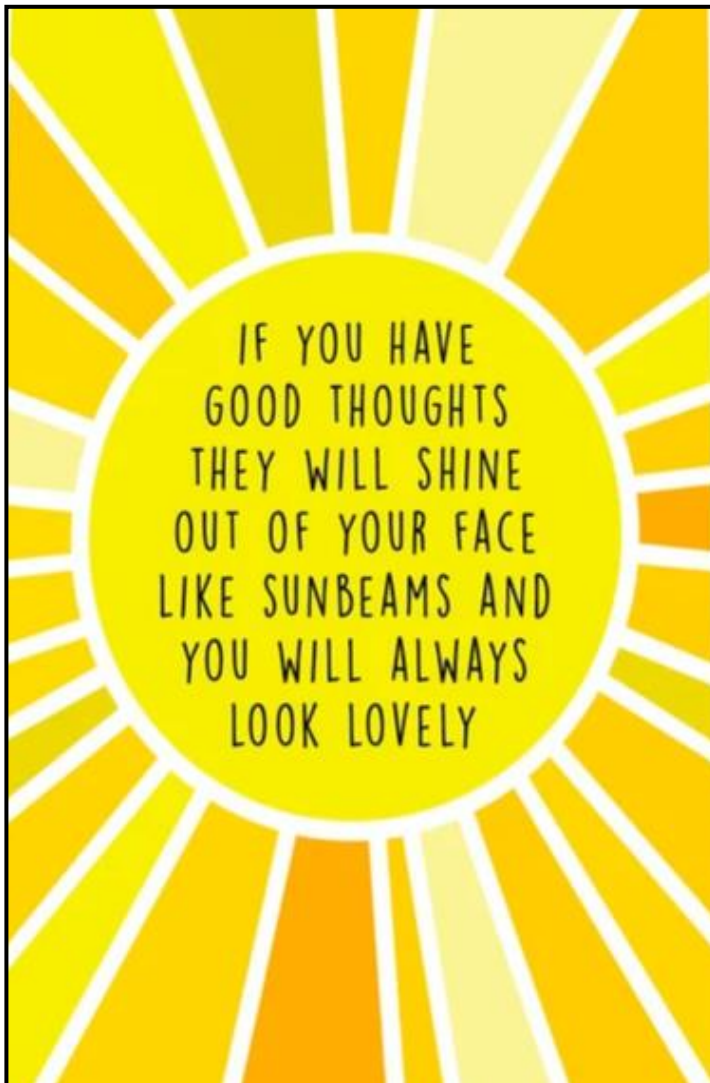
