We filed an official complaint with the post office today regarding the delays in our membership receiving their Promenade. While this will not help with those who have not gotten their August Promenade (we got ours yesterday), we hope it resolves the problem going forward. We have had a number of inquires regarding our mailing policy and process. The Promenade is labeled on the 4th Tuesday of each month. It is taken to the post office the next day. We pay periodical class postage which is second priority only to 1st class mail. Our representative at the post office said normal delivery time for the state of Texas should be 4 to 6 days. For the past two years the mailing process has been done electronically. There has been no change in our process since August 2009 when we converted to the electronic system.

Please let your members know we understand their concerns. We hope our efforts the past week result in better service going forward.Let's Do It!
