Her kids try to help Karen as much as possible and include her in their school activities. Usually on weekends the family will go out to eat at a favorite restaurant as long as the weather is good and Karen feels up to it. Bill continues to work 4 days a week and spends Wednesdays with Karen.

Adam started radiation for prostate cancer in early January. He has finished 11 of the 42 treatments they feel he needs. He is doing great so far and we expect that he will do fine. He goes 5 days a week and will finish in the first half of March.
