YOU are NORTEX. You, the dancers and members of square dance, round dance, and clogging are all NORTEX. There are a few people who so willingly give of their time, effort, and energy to serve you, the dancers, as elected and appointed officers of NORTEX. Come to think of it, the elected officers do not even have a vote on any issues. The business of the organization is conducted by the Club Presidents and Delegates of each club.

Now, what does the organization provide for each dancer and club? Let's think about this for a few minutes. Each Dancer is provided with a monthly Promenade magazine. Each club Is provided with liability insurance coverage for the locations where they dance. There is a large list of educational materials that are made available to the clubs free of charge (with the exception of a mainstream booklet). All that is necessary to take advantage of these materials is a request form provided to the Education Officer, Billy Hurt.

Oh, by the way, there is an Officer Installation Dance for all NORTEX members free of charge. Remember there is a NORTEX Teen Scholarship Dance for all members that is provided for donations only. Then the really big event is a full day of fun and fellowship — Round-Up. Profits from the last four Round-Ups were used to pay the insurance for each club. Because there is a Round-Up each year, clubs are able to participate in Pre Round-Up dances which offer an extra way for clubs to increase their revenue.

The NORTEX officers try to have a minimum of 2 squares attending each of the two big dances a club hosts each year – Pre Round-Up and Anniversary Dance, which adds to the donations collected for these dances.

So, see, we are all NORTEX working together for the betterment of our organization.
