We will certainly finish out our term as 2nd VPs.

We contacted Dave & Lorraine Burson, as they were the Nominating Committee Chairpersons this year, and asked that they meet with us this to discuss a replacement nominee. We reviewed a number of names and the top of our list was Ralph and Lucy Hamm. Lorraine called them and discussed the issue with them and they agreed to the nomination.

So, this brings us to needing a club vote to make it official. This Friday following our dance we will have a club meeting in the cafeteria – next to the gym where we dance – to discuss their nomination, open the floor for opposing nominations and vote. Your precents would be greatly appreciated.
