# **DANCE LESSONS**

Note the following from JL and Linda Pelton:

Beginning Bolaro starts Tuesday, the 21st -- if you have not signed up through Carpenter Rec Center, you need to do so NOW in order for the class to "make." Did you know that the 21st is only about a week away.

There have been some questions regarding this class. First, you do not need to have any round dance experience to take this class. You need to know your left foot from your right and whether you are male or female -- and we can get you charts and diagrams.

Seriously, it does not matter what rhythm you start to learn in your round dance journey. Everything you learn in any class helps you learn something else in a later class. Just like Dancing with the Stars, there is no particular rhythm you should start with to learn how to Round Dance.

Bolero is a slow Latin rhythm. It gives you time to think, oh, that's how I might do that. A class to learn Bolero doesn't happen very often so it's an opportunity to learn a rhythm you might not get an opportunity to learn unless you join a Round Dance Club. But, you might think, Bolero's are not danced very often at square dances. Unlike a jive which is obvious to a non-dancer, Bolero looks a lot like Rumba and so it may not be recognized. JL and Linda have already gotten a list from Walter for the Boleros he has in his repertoire and they will be sharing with him the dances that the students can take. So there will be more Boleros cued at Swinging Stars. When you go to Kissin Kuzzins, there will be Boleros cued for you since JL will know the dances you can do in this rhythm.

Also for future planning -- remember that JL and Linda will be teaching a class of Beginning Two Step starting March 18 right after the Bolero class is finished.
