We have less than <u>1 week</u> to review our assignments and make sure we know what is expected of each of us. We have just ½ hour to set up and decorate the dance floor before early rounds begin at 7pm. Once this area is completed, we will move into the dining hall to set up and decorate that room. If you find yourself with some spare time, you may come early to help so our committee chairs won't feel so stressed by the time constraints.

You may deliver your food to the tables in the area of the school (where we usually dine). Food will be moved to the dining room once the tables are set up and decorated. Disposable platters or plates are desirable, but if you want to bring your food on expensive "Star Glow" china, be sure to label your plate with your name so you can retrieve it at the end of the evening. I have some serving pieces and will be buying toothpicks to pick up things like olives and pickles and other things, but I could use more serving pieces (labeled with your name, of course). As stated in the last newsletter, we have no access to a kitchen, so dirty plates will be placed in the back room. There will be paper towels for you to wipe off your plates for transport to home.

We are not going to announce this at the dance, so read this carefully. Our guests will go through the dinner lines first. So unless you are a diabetic and just have to eat, we will all wait until the lines have lessened before we eat.

Russ is wearing his tuxedo and plans on circulating the dining room sort of as a butler, serving food to our guests.

I have had to juggle assignments around some as the Burson's have asked we close the Honey Pot and Money Auction at 9pm so the drawings can be done at a reasonable time.

At 9:30 we will stop serving dinner and start taking down the dining hall. The entire club is expected to help with the clean-up which includes the dance hall at the end of the evening.


Dance of Interest
