Plus 4s, Wednesday, January 21st

16 Swinging Stars visited Plus 4s in Farmers Branch on Wednesday. The evening's all-plus tips were called by veteran club caller Charles Quisenberry, aka "Quiz." On this particular evening, Quiz spent a lot of time "teaching" rather than just barking complex calls. Yes, he did still engineer some of his "patented" intricacies such as moves involving a diamond of ladies within an outer big box of men. However, Quiz spent much more time than usual painstakingly teaching and repeating a few variants of some specific calls. For example, he drilled us on the "centers' part" of Load the Boat, often from two parallel in-facing lines with the 4-person boxes on each end of the lines doing the "centers' part" simultaneously. Many dancers struggled with this unusual directive for some time, but Quiz patiently repeated the essential definition of "couples pass through, each dancer then turns back on partner, all dancers then trade with new partner, and couples finally pass through again." Eventually, all dancers learned how important it is to know and keep track of who your partner is at every instant. Similarly, Quiz drilled dancers repeatedly on "Left Relay the Deucey" and "Left Spin Change and Double Exchange the Gears." All attendees had a great time and came away better and/or more confident dancers. Visiting Swinging Stars included Bondis, Bergesens, Bursons, Colters, Esteps, Hawkins, Kerns, and Kilejians.
