Here are a few interesting facts about our Club Caller and Club Cuer that you may not know:

Wayne Baldwin began calling in 1967 with his first clubs in Kermit, Texas and Jal, New Mexico. Soon he was calling Square Dances all over the Southwest. During these past 49 years Wayne, with his wife Jodie, had the pleasure of traveling within Alberta and British Columbia Provinces in Canada, Alaska, Saudi Arabia, Holland, and most of the United States west of the Mississippi and in all of "The Deep South" where he was a sought after featured festival caller. Wayne always felt that the greatest contribution he could make to Square Dancing was to bring new people into the activity and teach new dancers. Some of his greatest memories are from the 31 years Wayne was on staff at Fun Valley, Colorado, and five years on staff at the Banff Institute. He has recorded on Blue Star, Brogan, Roadrunner, Circle "D and Global Records. Currently Wayne calls and teaches for the Swinging Stars of Plano, Model A' in Dallas, and Kissin' Kuzzins in Garland. Wayne has been the club caller for Swinging Stars and Model A's for 38 years and the club caller for the Kissin' Kuzzins for 4 years. He is a longtime member of Callerlab, Texas Callers Association, and North Texas Callers Association. Wayne was inducted into the "Texas Callers' Hall of Fame" on October 31, 2009.

Walter Brewer began Cueing in 1991 and has been the club cuer for Swinging Stars since 2007. He has cued the past few years in Fun Valley as well as a number of state conventions and the National Convention. Walter teams up with Jerry Story for the Story Time dances in Tool. Walter writes round dancing choreography and most recently wrote the Watermark phase four for the Round-a-lab's rounds of the quarter. He is Past President of the NTCA (North Texas Callers Association). He served two terms as Presidents of Texas Round Dance Teachers Assoc. Walter's timing is flawless and he makes round dancing FUN & light-hearted while challenging the floor to excel at their dancing ability. He works tirelessly to make sure our dancers are laughing and fully engaged in the dance.
