"These officers shall be elected from the Club members to a six-month term beginning February 1st and August 1st of each year. Elections shall take place at November and May quarterly club meetings. An officer may not succeed himself more than once unless approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the members present and voting, with the exception of the Treasurer's position, which may not be held consecutively for more than two six-month terms."

We can not have a business meeting unless we have a quorum. A quorum at all Club meetings shall consist of the presence of at least one-fourth of the members of the Club and at least two officers of the Club.

Please plan to attend. When I made the reservation at Spring Creek they were very reluctant to reserve it on a Sunday. Saying that was one of their busiest days. The manager went ahead and reserved it for us. So please let's make it worth their while to let us have our meeting there, so we can continue to hold our meetings in their restaurant.
