Quarter Dues are due!!

PLANNING

I would like to say a word about planning to go square dancing.

An important part of going square dancing is to plan ahead. If you do not plan to go, you probably will not go. This is why we send out a calendar each month, so that you can go over it and see where the club is planning to go dancing. When you receive the calendar each month, print it out so you will have it at hand, to be able to check where it is the Swinging Stars are going to be dancing. If you don't plan in advance to attend a dance you probably will not go. I know that many members already do this and they do go dancing with the club frequently. But obviously not all members do this or we would have a better participation for our visitation to other clubs. If you are only dancing once a month or less after taking lessons you are not going to get the most from your efforts. Members need to dance as frequently as they can to get the most of their square dancing experience. If you are a person that is afraid that you will break down a square if you miss a call, just remember that we all mess up sometimes and have not always been the best dancers. It takes practice, practice, practice.

Quick reminder about Round up registration:

NTCA CAVALCADE is Oct.19th, \$ 10 per person at the door. ROUND UP is Oct. 20th \$ 25 per person at the door.

Note: Mail-in registration must have been postmarked by 9/15/2018, so it is closed.

The cutoff date for online registration was October 1st, 2018. It is also closed.

You can still buy advanced tickets from the Area VPs or from the Round-Up Chairs (Sheila Milliron & Bobby Clark) or buy full priced tickets at the door.

One more note of interest for those of us that collect Friendship badge signatures. I contacted John Curry, President of NORTEX, to inquire about the signatures for Cavalcade and Roundup. There seemed to be some confusion about the signatures we could get and those we could not. This is his reply: "Hi Lorraine. The friendship fun rules says the NORTEX President can designate any dance as

a NORTEX dance for the purpose of signatures, so the 5 limit will not apply in the case of Cavalcade. The actual Round-Up will be a double signature dance, so a total of three signatures can be gotten. John Curry"


