Thursday October 15, Roadrunners Monster Mash Theme Dance and Double Deal

6 Swinging Stars visited the Road Runners' double-deal "Monster Mash" dance at Swingtime Center in Fort Worth on Thursday. It was a great dance featuring Nebraska native Dan Nordbye on squares and the beloved Karen Gloodt on rounds. As the evening progressed, Karen cued a broad mix of rhythms and difficulties that allowed every round dancer to dance at least some, if not all, of the time. On squares, Dan began with a workshop featuring "Meet a Friend," a new call to most of us ... in which the centers of any 4-person line (single-faced, two-faced, wave, whatever) run around the ends and roll while the ends slide toward each other, face, and pass through. The call finishes in a 4-person column with the 2 rollers on each end facing in and the 2 passers through in the center, back to back, facing the rollers. During the remainder of the evening, Dan called a great array of rapidly paced tips, including 2 plus tips and some very nice singing calls. All dancers, many dressed as various Halloween ghouls, goblins, and myriad of monsters, had a terrific time. Swinging Stars present included Bondis, Pitts, and Sees. Huge thanks to all 3 couples attending and I extend my utmost appreciation to Jim Bondi for making this report.

Saturday October 17, Buttons and Bows Shake, Rattle & Roll Theme Dance
