**Square Dance History of the Week –** Since the waltz and polka gained popularity at the same time as the Quadrille, couple dances have probably always been part of square dance evenings. However, in 1950 the new dancers did not know how to do the old-time couple dances, so callers began cueing them. To avoid collisions, a circle pattern was used and thus modern, cued Round Dancing was born. New round dances were choreographed to modern tunes almost as fast as new square dance movements were created. Soon special teachers for round dancing emerged, some with ballroom and foreign folk dance backgrounds. These people brought the skills to branch out into new rhythms. They quickly borrowed the popular ballroom dances and we soon had separate clubs dedicated to learning and dancing rounds.
