Thank you to our future executive board and the nomination committee members for your willingness to serve our club in these vital roles. It is critical to have good talent leading our club.

We also approved the purchase of an Assisted Listening transmitter. We narrowed it down to two units – the Listen and the Williams unit. A committee was appointed consisting of Charlie Harris, Richard Covington, Bob Pitts, Fred Underwood and John Barber to make the final determination within financial guidelines defined. In addition, we took up a donation to go toward the purchase of the transmitter. We will have a donation basket at our next couple of dances or until adequate money is accumulated to make the purchase. John Barber, our treasurer indicated that we need to wait till 01/01/2014 to disperse the funds. Now, we need the unit no later than our Anniversary dance and we would like to get it as soon as possible. So, please give generously to this important acquisition. Club members need to purchase their own receivers and Fred encouraged members to check out the Williams Sound R37N FM receiver. It is a little smaller than the Listen receiver and it automatically seeks out 17 frequencies broadcasted by the transmitter so listeners don't have to fumble with tuning controls. It's also field tunable to match the frequency of your choice. It is digitally synthesized for greater audio clarity and stability. It has a channel-lock capability to prevent accidental channel change. Priced at \$84.99 + ear piece \$14.99 + shipping. You can purchase it at www.audiolinks.com. I included the flyer on the Listen unit in last week's newsletter. Fred also indicated that they have the analog Listen LR200 at \$76 + ear piece + shipping. You will note that it only has three channels and the batteries have to be removed to move a sliding selector switch to change the channel.

Both brands are compatible with the two transmitters that we are considering.
