## Friendship Plus, December 9th

For example, we performed most tips in a 6-couple "square" using 2 couples in each of the head positions. Mike workshopped us through moves we already knew but with 2 extra couples. We learned that Spin Chain the Gears now involved 3 parallel waves with each outer wave interacting with the center wave to simultaneously do two interacting Spin Chain the Gears. Other common moves, like Tea Cup Chain, also required new tricks. Under Mike's careful tutelage, initially glazed eyes always gradually morphed into smiling faces as the evening progressed. Visiting Swinging Stars were Bondis and Kilejians. Thanks to Jim Bondi for the dance details.
