RECENT ACTIVITY -- DANCING

All-Rounds Dance

Sunday 31 Jauary -- Harvest Holiday - "Winter Fun Rounds"

Six Swinging Stars round dancers; our club cuer, Walter and Eula Brewer; and Swinging Stars members and round dance lessons instructors, JL and Linda Pelton participated in the Harvest Holiday Phase II – IV "fun dance" last Sunday afternoon. It was a great 3-hour event which gave us the opportunity to dance virtually all of the round dance rhythms to the cueing of seven area cuers. The dances cued included "Little by Little", a jive choreographed by Walter and Eula, and "Dance with the Devil", a cha-cha choreographed by JL and Linda. Also included were many dances requested from the floor. Each of the cuers led the dancers in five to six songs, a total of about 40 dances, so we had a good workout and a lot of fun. Participating cuers, in addition to Walter and JL, were Chris Farabaugh, Karen Gloodt, Christine Hixson, Jack Kenny, and Jack von der Heide. Swinging Stars attending included Bondis, Hamms, and Perrotts. Also attending were Ellen Chen and Joe Zhang, members of the Dance Arounds round dance club who are currently taking our square dance lessons.

A1 Lessons & Plus Dance


