Bob Estep reports that he is doing as well as can be expected 2.5 months after his bone marrow transplant. He had a significant cough that did not allow him to sleep. He also experienced swelling in both feet with large blisters that made it difficult to walk. The swelling has decreased over the past week. He also had to use a cane for 4 weeks. The major concern is that the transplant wipes out all immune defenses including childhood vaccinations, and it is flu season. The vaccinations cannot be started until a year after the transplant. Therefore, he is quarantined at home and cannot have visitors. He says that, except for total lack of energy, he feels pretty good. He says thanks to everyone for your thoughts and prayers.
