#### A brief update from Jean and Adam about their daughter Karen.

A week ago Wednesday, when Karen went in for her regular chemo treatment, they could not find a vein. She & Bill met with the Surgeon last Friday to discuss a permanent port for her chemo IV & blood draws. This past Wednesday, Karen had the procedure done to get her permanent port placed. It was a very long day for everyone. She tolerated everything fine but faltered a little at the end - the anesthesia and not eating all day caught up with Karen just as she got home and she had a little seizure.

Spent yesterday with Karen, & Wendy was visiting too. Just as we were helping her move out of her wheelchair she had another seizure. Bill is staying home with her today and let us know that they are adjusting some of her seizure meds. Before yesterday, she hadn't had a seizure for quite some time. Karen should be fine to resume her every other week chemo treatments next Wednesday, and having the port should make that so much easier for her.

Thank you for being there and continuing to pray for us. Some days are so much harder than others. We thank God that we still have Karen with us, but we know her struggle is getting harder for her & for all of us. We realize that her brain tumor will continue to grow and is preventing her from overcoming any of the effects of the stroke.
