But, just to make sure, we attend one Waltz lesson to see how it would be. It was a disaster. We were "taught" two waltzes that night. But Peggy and I mostly just stumbled over each other's feet. We couldn't even do the box step.

We were at a square dance weekend in Oklahoma one Thanksgiving weekend with another couple. It was announced that a free introductory round dance lesson was offered at 8:30 on Saturday morning. The other couple expressed an interest and said they'd be going to take the lessons. We agreed to go down and watch them.

Saturday morning, we went down, but they didn't show up. We were there... Peggy even got up and going early enough to make the 8:30 time. The cuer was very persuasive and sold us on the Cha-cha. So we took the lesson and were hooked. But what could we do about it when we got back to Plano. EVERYONE starts with Waltz and Two-step.

Fortunately (or unfortunately as may be the case) John Brewer, now Walter, was offering beginning lessons within a month of our return home and he was starting with Cha and Rumba.
