#### "A" Lessons & All-Plus Dance

This week, Charles Quisenberry ("Quiz") introduced "A" students to A2 calls "Pass and Roll," "Scoot Chain Through," and "Out Roll Circulate." He also drilled them on recently introduced calls such as "Scoot & Weave," "In Roll Circulate," "Split Counter Rotate," and "Single Wheel." In the following all-Plus dance, 22 Swinging Stars enjoyed Quiz's clever patter choreography and occasional singing calls. During tonight's patter, Quiz challenged dancers with a few "lefty" variations, including Spin Chain Exchange the Gears (starting from a left-handed wave). Some squares got it immediately, some needed a little help. As is always the case at a Quiz-led dance, all present had a good time and, by evening's end, had solidified or even improved their plus dancing skills. # Friday-Sunday 08-10 April – Log Cabin Swingers – 16th Annual "Swing Into Spring"

11 Swinging Stars journeyed to the Log Cabin Swingers' Promenade Hall in Tool, TX to enjoy a weekend of squaring to the world-renown calling of Jerry Story and masterful cueing of Walter Brewer. And enjoy it they did! Round dancers got a weekend of varied rhythms and phases featuring early rounds before evening dances, a Saturday morning teach, and a Saturday afternoon request hour. Walter made an appreciated effort to honor requests throughout the weekend. On squares, Jerry was ... uh ... Jerry, drilling dancers through rapid-paced and inventive patter choreography, slowing or pausing to tutor only as required, and periodically belting out some terrific singing calls. Square dancers often come from afar to get a dose of Jerry, as evidenced by one couple from Sweden. (OK, they were spending a few weeks in Texas & Louisiana, vacationing and dancing to more than just Jerry, but he WAS part of the reason for their trip.) Saturday morning and afternoon workshops helped prepare square dancers for the special half-hour, mid-afternoon DBD dance session. That was a real experience, often challenging dancers to their limits even though largely focused this time on varieties / sequences of circulates, trades, and runs. When choreographed cleverly by Jerry, sequences of these typically simple calls often become extraordinary ... exactly what his fans love and eagerly anticipate. Saturday evening featured the traditional "in-house" after-party while Sunday morning featured Log Cabin's pancake & sausage breakfast, Jerry's beloved gospel singing, and a closing square/round dance session.
