Some of us have encountered the "hacking" of Facebook accounts. Three friends received requests for "friending" me who are already on my list. I consulted our family expert. She said "don't delete the account, ... It happens all of the time. Setting up a fake account is done most frequently to seniors. The best thing is to report it to Facebook--easiest way is for the people receiving notifications to report it. There is an option to report on the notification. or you can go to Help and report on the notification yourself. Facebook will delete the fake account. 40 minutes later she told me she had searched and found the fake account and reported it. (I was going to do it when I got back home). 20 minutes later Facebook notified me they had received her report and said they would take it seriously. They also sent an email to my real friend saying these reports were an important part of keeping Facebook safe. So the problem was solved for now. If you receive a fake friend request, click the spot and report it to Facebook. Thanks to Nina for suggesting I share. Many of you probably know all about this problem but to some this is a new experience.
