Sunshine information

Today is May 5th or Cinco de Mayo. The following is a short history surrounding this date in Mexico: Napoleon III, emperor of France decided to expand his country's influence internationally. He decided, among other areas of the world, to establish a 2nd Empire specifically in Mexico, which was in financial difficulties. In 1862 he sent a large army which landed in Puebla as the first invasion point. President Juarez sent his army to defend the city and the French were repelled on May 5th. Cinco de Mayo became a national holiday. Unfortunately the French were only stopped temporarily and they were able to establish a monarchy with Austrian Archduke Ferdinand Maxmillan as Emperor. The conservative wealthy elements of the nation supported him at first; the other people did not. President Juarez and his men taught the French the meaning of guerilla warfare. Juarez established his government in exile in El Paso. The US was involved in the Civil War and did not invoke the Monroe Doctrine. The North did not want to anger the French, fearing financial support for the Confederacy. Finally in April of 1864 President Abraham Lincoln recognized the Juarez government. Secretary of State Seward and General Grant organized some support. Arms, money and men went to Juarez's troops.. 3,000 Union veterans joined Juarez's army. In 1867 the French withdrew from Mexico and Emperor Maximilan was caught and executed. 50,000 Mexicans lost their lives fighting the French during the 6 years of French occupation. Cinco de Mayo is only a state holiday celebrated in Puebla. (Meyer/Sherman THE COURSE OF MEXICAN HISTORY reference).
