# **BEHIND THE SCENES**

For those of you who may not know, the GRaM Committee stands for Growth, Retention and Motivation. It is a Square & Round Dance committee of NORTEX & NTCA. The Gram Committee will be testing transmitter/receiver Hearing Enhancement systems at a square dance near you. FM signals generated by the transmitter easily cover the normal dance hall and place the caller literally in your ear through fairly inexpensive standard FM band transmitter (88 to 108 MHz). The biggest detail is in getting and verifying the proper signal level from the amplifier to the transmitter. The greatest benefit in using the standard FM band is

that the sound can be picked up on any pocket FM radio receiver - and even a cell phone, if it is so capable. Once we have completed our evaluation, we will let you know the outcome. Please contact us if you have any questions or comments.
