In the main dance, Walter Brewer cued a broad mix of round dance rhythms (including Cha's & Rhumbas targeted at Peltons' current students) and phases while Wayne continued his terrific work on squares. At dance's end, a couple squares tested their fast-dancing abilities at some Hot Hash. Post-dance, 12 Swinging Stars partied on a bit more at On the Border in Plano.
