The NTCA met today and discussed several NORTEX dances coming up – August 25^{th} is a Pre-Roundup Kickoff & Food Drive. It is from 4:30 - 6:30 at the Plymouth Park United Methodist Church in Irving. There will be two halls running simultaneously both with Mainstream and Rounds with callers and cuers rotating between rooms.

The Cavalcade at Roundup will run from 7:00 - 10:00 on November 1st with early rounds from 7:00 - 7:45 and Grand March at 8:00 with a \$5.00 pre-dance purchase and \$7.00 at the door. Before Cavalcade, caller trainees will call from 6:00 - 7:00 (no additional charge for attending this portion).

Toys for Tots dance will be Sunday, December 8th at the Richardson Civic Center - it will be decorated with Santa Booths for the Christmas season. Chip Wagner for the local TV station will be on hand and there will be possible TV coverage. The Hall rents for \$2,000 and hopefully we will be able to offset the cost with sponsors at \$100 each. It was noted that this is an excellent opportunity for clubs to hand out their lessons brochures as there will be a lot of people walking through the area.

* * * Note from Your 2nd VPs * * *

Hello Swinging Stars. We discovered not all our dancers are aware of how the Friendship Fun visitation awards activity operates. Signing the guest book list at other club dances does NOT work towards automatically earning the Friendship gold and silver dangles. The dancers need to obtain gold and / or silver signature cards and secure 25 signatures that meet the respective requirements for each to get a dangle (every multiple of 25 gets a new dangle). Silver dangles have easier requirements and are usually faster to achieve than the gold dangles. We carry the gold card in our wallet and have it signed at each dance we visit. Remember anniversary and double deal dances count two times, and therefore cards should be signed twice by the club officers at the check in desk. We hope this information helps, and we will bring some of the signature cards to our next club dance – find us to get one, or you can print one off at the above link. When the cards are full, they are to be returned to Peggy Amy (Friendship Fun Chair). The dangles are presented to the recipients at our Swinging Star club dances.

The GRaM Committee finished their first round of testing the Transmitter & Receivers for the Hearing Enhancement systems the Swingtime Center this past week. The inexpensive receivers, \$3 units, proved to be inadequate. They plan to move up to a little more expensive unit to see if it improves the reception.

These ALD, Assisted Listening Devices, use FM signals generated by the transmitter and these units litterally place the caller voice in your ear. Once they have completed their evaluation, we will let you know the outcome.
