RECENT ACTIVITY -- DANCING/TRAINING

"A" Lessons

Wednesday 18 May, 6:15 - 7:30 - Plus 4s

This week, "A" instructor, Charles Quisenberry ("Quiz"), focused largely on reviewing / "burning in" calls that were already introduced earlier. Tonight, among other calls, students were drilled on Motivate. Quiz wants students to understand that, to do such intricate maneuvers well, they must not only know their specific part, but must stay synchronized with others, not getting behind <u>or</u> ahead, as the maneuver progresses. Only in this way can the overall 8-person structure stay properly shaped and have its various parts interact properly (e.g., for Motivate, have its 3 stars that appear be well-formed and interact properly as they rotate). Swinging Stars students taking these lessons include Bondis, Heintz/Putnam, and Sees. Swinging Stars angels helping out this week were: P. Amy. Quiz now anticipates finishing the current lessons by end of May.

All-Plus Dance

Wednesday 18 May, 7:30 - 9:30 - Plus 4s

13 Swinging Stars visited Plus 4s in Farmers Branch Wednesday for their biweekly all-plus dance. In his inimitable fashion, club caller, Charles Quisenberry ("Quiz"), entertained dancers while occasionally throwing them a "pop quiz" maneuver. This evening, Quiz's "pop quiz" maneuver to enhance dancers' education was LEFT Spin Chain and Exchange the Gears. After a bit of help with the potentially tricky LEFT-handed nature of this move, dancers were starting to master it. A big thank you to these Swinging Stars for turning out: P. "A" Dance

Thursday 19 May – Model As

7 Swinging Stars visited Model A's in Dallas on Thursday evening for their weekly "A" dance. Attendance tonight was a bit light but the 2-3 squares dancing enjoyed the experience. Swinging Stars present were P. Amy, Bondis, Evantos, and Shermans. When newcomers (e.g., new "A" dancers such as Bondis) sometimes needed help, experienced dancers present were always ready to lend a gracious helping hand.

Hi-Level DBD Plus Dance

Wednesday-Thursday 18-19 May - Jerry Story

4 Swinging Stars headed to Speegleville, TX (just west of southern end of Waco, TX) for the annual high-level DBD Plus dance called there by Jerry Story. (Until recently, this dance was held in the "Treehouse" venue at Marble Falls, TX.) Dancers came to "be tested" by Jerry's inventive choreography ... and tested they were ... during four 2-hour DBD sessions over Wed afternoon to Thu afternoon. Wow! Some of Jerry's testing this time included a host of trickier-than-typical Linear Cycles starting from non-wave lines (e.g., from 2-faced lines with couples on each end having to begin by first facing for a Partner Hinge; and also from inverted lines with couples on each end oriented to hinge with opposite rotations (one right, one left) and ultimately peel in opposite directions). He also drilled dancers on some intricate sequences that began with the "first part of Crossfire" (centers trade while ends cross-fold) and then continued on with other moves. Overall, the dancing was always fast-paced, moderately difficult on up to square-busting tough, often educational, and always exhilarating. "A" dancers were treated to one Advanced tip following each 2-hour session. Swinging Stars participating in this event were Bondis and Evantos.

Square + Round Dance

Friday 20 May - Kissin Kuzzins -- "Red, White, & Blue - Honor Vet's"

35 Swinging Stars visited the Kissin Kuzzins in Garland on Friday night for their "Red, White, & Blue" dance. Early dancing began at 7:00 PM with popular cuer, J.L. Peton, offering 30 minutes of early rounds that included a few challenging dances. At 7:30, club caller, Wayne Baldwin, work-shopped dancers through 30 minutes of basic square dance moves. Following the grand march at 8:00, Wayne and J.L alternated between squares and rounds for the remainder of the dance. Via their combined efforts, both square and round dancers were afforded many opportunities to exercise and improve their skills. Throughout the evening, dancers adorned in various forms of patriotic red, white, & blue apparel weaved and bobbed across the floor, smiling as they enjoyed their craft and each other's company. Saturday 21 May - Trail Blazers - 46th Anniversary - "Seems Like a Fairy Tale"

8 Swinging Stars journeyed to Swingtime Center in Fort Worth to enjoy the Trail Blazer's 46th Anniversary Dance on Saturday evening. A total crowd of over 120 came to enjoy this event. As you stepped into the hall, because of the children's fairy tale books opened on table tops and the fairy-tale like paintings adorning the walls, you felt almost as if you'd stepped into an actual fairy tale. 90 minutes of early dance activities kicked off at 6:30. First up, cuer Jack Kenney delivered 30 minutes of sometimes sophisticated rounds including his own waltz, "After Winter," and K. Gloodt's new bolero, "Mi Vida Sin Tu Amor" (My Life Without Your Love). Next, Jack continued with 30 more minutes of more-typical "square dance level" rounds before yielding the floor. Finally, club caller, Bobby Willis, and guest caller, Jim Howard of Oklahoma, presented a 30 minute squares workshop before dancers fell into formation for the grand march. From that point on, attendees enjoyed 2+ more hours of dancing, including 2 Plus tips and a wide variety of rounds, and a great spread of food prepared by our hosts. 
