"A" Lessons

Instructor, Charles Quisenberry ("Quiz"), focused mostly on review this week, the exception being "Split (or Box) Transfer," which was practically new to most students. As review, much time was spent improving our execution of Motivate (with students getting a chance to do the call from "different" starting positions), Spin the Windmill, and Chain Reaction. To give students more needed training, Quiz has decided to extend the lessons for several more weeks but, going forward, only on 1st, 3rd, & 5th Wednesdays, immediately before the Plus 4s normal dance. Friday 27 May, Swinging Stars

Nearly 70 dancers, including a few visitors, enjoyed the Swinging Stars dance Friday evening at Shepard Elementary School in Plano. To begin, Walter Brewer cued 45 minutes of varied early rounds, including many that Peltons' recent Cha/Rhumba graduates could enjoy and Wayne Baldwin then called 15 minutes of interesting early Plus that kept dancers "on their toes." After the Grand March, 1st VP, Russ Nejdl (filling in for Pres. Bob Estep) kicked off the main dance like an "experienced pro." Round and square dancers, including 2 recent Main Stream graduate Swinging Stars couples, enjoyed the next 2 hours of alternating square and round dancing. Finally, 3 enthusiastic squares formed up to test their "fast dancing mettle" at a tip of Wayne's Hot Hash. Afterward, ~ 20 dancers, callers, & cuers regrouped at On the Border in Plano to party on a bit longer.

Festivities began with Early Rounds by club cuer, Chris Farabaugh, followed by a Square Workshop by guest caller, Bobby Willis. During the main dance, Bobby Willis surprised and reminded many dancers just how interesting good Main Stream can be when he called Wheel and Deal from FACING (not the usual back-to-back) parallel lines of 4. Many squares initially struggled with this until Bobby patiently and repeatedly demonstrated that the same definition we all learned long ago in Main Stream class still applies ... as written ... without modification ... to yield a column of 4 couples all facing out from square's center (rather than in) in so-called "Completed Double Pass Thru" formation. As Bobby's tutoring took hold, the red color initially on many faces gave way to a smile. A very big thank you goes to these Swinging Stars participating: P. Amy, Bondis, Brewers (new members), Evantos, Hamms, Sees, and Trujillos. With this attendance, we earned another club visitation signature (we're closing rapidly on 600 now) but said "nay" to their banner (since we already have one).


