Square Dance Lessons Update.

Lessons will begin on September 4th at 7:30 in the upstairs room of Carpenter Recreation Center. Our own Wayne Baldwin will teach them. Graduation is scheduled for December 18th. The forms and sign up sheet will be available at the first dance in June and continue at dances following. Jodie would like the background check forms, especially for September angels, back by the end of July.


