RECENT ACTIVITY -- DANCING/TRAINING

Early "A" Dance + All-Plus Dance

Wednesday 15 June, Plus 4s

This was the first of several planned, special Plus 4s evenings providing 75 minutes of early all-A1/A2 dancing for recent graduates of Quiz's 2016 "A" class. New graduates (including Swinging Stars Bondis & Sees) were joined by numerous, experienced angels to do some real "A" dancing. This format will be repeated for several weeks/months, offering the new "A" dancers very badly needed "floor time." Afterward, in the main, all-PLUS dance, 16 Swinging Stars participated. As always, Quiz had some educational "twists" up his sleeve for this dance. Tonight's "twists" focused on some serious Load the Boat training including: a.) from parallel lines of 4 with all facing in, "All do the Centers Part of Load the Boat" and b.) from parallel inverted lines with ends facing out and centers facing in, "Load the Boat." The first tests your detailed understanding of the centers part, requiring you to really focus on who your partner is at every step of the way, especially during the initial pass through and the subsequent trade. The second tests your detailed knowledge of the ends part, and makes it clear why it really is important to count, as you circulate, how many other ends you pass and to turn/face in just after the 3rd pass. Good job, Quiz. It's this patented combination of fun with some spurts of real training that makes Plus 4s unique. Many thanks to this set of Plus-4s-supportive Swinging Stars participating: P. 
