We can't guarantee we will be there for the entire dance as Russ tires easily and requires icing and pain medications. He will be unable to dance until next year but can visit with you. It ran its course just the way the doctor told me it would and I had a mild case. I have to wear a mask for another 5 days, but will wear a mask at the dance on Friday night just to play it safe. Russ will test this weekend and probably at the end of the week to make sure he did not get sick. I was lucky I had a mild case and that I did not get his 2 and half years ago.
