June 27,2021 NORTEX Pre Roundup Kickoff Dance.

They both did an excellent job getting the excitement to a high level for a fun afternoon of dancing, With the competition of the Nationals .in Jackson, Mississippi, as expected attendance was not as high as would have been wanted. The 45th International Choreographed Ballroom Dance Convention (ICBDA)

From June 29 - July 3, the 45th International Choreographed Ballroom Dance Convention (ICBDA) was held in Rockport, Tennessee. The Marriott Meadowview Conference Center and Resort hosted 330 dancers from 35 states. Five European countries, Japan, Canada and Australia were unable to send dancers due to COVID.

From the Dallas/Fort Worth area, Karen and Ed Gloodt and JL and Linda Pelton were part of the cueing staff for the convention. (JL is also webmaster for ICBDA). JL and Karen cued 6 dances each on Wednesday night and JL cued an additional 6 on Friday night. Dancers from the Dallas/Fort Worth area included the Hamms and the Zhangs from Dance Arounds (led by JL and Linda Pelton), 3 couples from Ramblin Rounds (led by Christine and Theron Hixson), 2 couples from Rainbow Rounds (led by Karen and Ed Gloodt), and 6 couples from Harvest Holiday (led by the Gloodts, the Hixsons and the Peltons). Harvest Holiday members are also members of other round dance clubs listed above. New cuers Jan and David Toms also attended.

Almost all of the DFW dancers attended the all-day Wednesday bolero clinic and dance "teach" with Randy and Marie Preskitt. They are internationally known choreographers, teachers and cuers from Seattle. They will be in Dallas in late November for a round dance weekend sponsored by Harvest Holiday.

12 new dances including foxtrot, waltz, jive, bolero, rumba, chacha and West Coast Swing were taught through the dance "teaches". 210 dances chosen in advance by votes of the membership were available to be danced in the evenings in 3 different ballrooms which were assigned phases 3-4, 4-5. 5-6 (based on easier, intermediate and hard levels of dances). Early in the evening 5 more dances of all phases were offered in Let's Dance Together each day. Everyone seems to have enjoyed the convention and seeing distant friends again.
