Round Dance Report

Alex and Vanessa Nestor were first time attendees to the ICBDA (round dance) convention on July 6 - 9th in Tulsa. Bill and Wendy Perrott attended also, their second time to Tulsa. Wendy and Vanessa have graciously been keeping me posted through emails. Ralph and I had been working on some of the selected older evening dances all year but we were able to watch videos at home and see the dances, which were taught last week. We noticed people we knew in the audience. Vanessa said 9 couples came from the north Texas area. We noticed several dancers wearing masks. Fortunately ICBDA has a stand by dance teachers list and used 3 couples to teach 3 of their own dances in place of 3 missing dance teaching couples. Two dances "teaches" and the 2 appropriate clinics were held each day. Ballrooms A, B and C were being used for the 3 different levels of dances. Everyone was free to choose whichever dance he/ she wished to learn. On Saturday morning the Hall of Fame dance for 2022 was announced.: Solitude City, a foxtrot. Many DFW area dancers know it. (All international as well as national members can vote each year). Karen and Ed Gloodt won in 2017 with their rumba, Cuando Me Enamoro. Each of the 4 nights dancing begins with 5 dances that received the highest votes back in May. Solitude City was on that list. Then the following 3 hours have 21 dances in each A-C ballroom for dancing.

Vanessa Nestor said the convention could be overwhelming but they really enjoyed attending. They couldn't learn many of the dances yet but they enjoyed watching. They received good information in the clinic /workshops. They were interested in watching a phase 6 Bolero for enjoyment. She said she really enjoyed watching Randy and Marie Prerskitt dance (foxtrot) because they dance so well. I told her we agree since we saw them at our 1st ICBDA in Reno (2016). (Last November we gave

them a ride from DFW to their hotel in Dallas. They were there for Harvest Holiday dance weekend.. They are also nice people). She said they went to watch the Peltons waltz dance "teach" on Thursday afternoon. "Their beautiful dance" went well. At night, the Nestors found the 3/4 hall (C) was fun and they could dance many dances.

Wendy and Bill Perrott said they are getting back to round dancing after his 2 hip replacements so this ICBDA was a good one for them. There was a wide variety of dance levels and rhythms. They improved their dance frame at the phase 5 waltz clinic and reviewed their phase 4 foxtrot figures at the Alley Cat Blues "teach" and learned basic West Coast Swing at the Cowboy Blues "teach". "The evening dancing was wonderful with lots of experienced cuers."
