"A" Dance followed by Plus Dance

Wednesday 20 July - Plus 4s -

During the early "A" dance, recent A graduates were joined by many seasoned A dancers including Amys, Evantos, Lewises, Morses, B. Sand, and N. Sawyer. Caller "Quiz" managed to find the right level of calls that challenged new dancers often enough to foster improvement in their skills while also entertaining seasoned dancers. Later, during the main Plus dance, a total of 10 Swinging Stars participated. This evening, Quiz's "bonus call" was Spin Chain and Double Exchange the Gears (1st half executes roughly like the common Single Exchange version but then each "snake of 4 dancers" folds back on itself and re-passes the other to ultimately regroup along its original position but finish as a LEFT-handed wave). For his part, Wayne entertained and sometimes challenged square dancers with more than two hours of solid Mainstream, strong Plus, some great singing calls (of course), and even a bit of Hot Hash as dancing wrapped up. Afterward, roughly 28 Swinging Stars found the energy to continue mingling and partying at our newest after-dance-venue, Austin Avenue Grill in Plano.
