Square Dance Tip of the Week - While dancing, hand holds are very important, but please be gentle. Dancers need to establish contact with adjacent dancers in their formation, as it is the way in which dancers guide each other, since no one can be alert every second; however, you should hold on loosely so the other dancers can get away if they are supposed to move and you don't realize it. When doing arm turn calls (left allemande, turn thru, etc.) grip lightly the forearm not the elbow. In waves, gently touch fingers and palms to adjacent dancers. Don't grab thumbs. Round Dancer information

The following information could be of interest to round dancers and particularly those who belong to Carousel round dance clubs. ICBDA (International Choreographed Ballroom Dance Association) began certifying, and recognizing Carousel round dance clubs many years ago. There are currently 65 Carousel Clubs in the association. These clubs must meet standards of teaching of round dancing at the intermediate and advanced levels of dancing and promote a common group of dances recognized across the dance community. Leaders submit reports of dances taught and choose

favorite dances each month. These reports publicize dances taught across the country and around the world. Votes are taken monthly. 14 US states, 3 other countries and Washington DC have one club each. Four US states and Sweden have two clubs. Folorida, Oregon, and Washington have three clubs. Arizona and Colorado have four clubs. California and Texas have 8 clubs each. The DFW area has 3 Carousel clubs.

For the month of July, 2 dances were tied for #1. They were a phase 6 foxtrot "I'm Beginning to See the Light", choreographed by internationally known Randy and Marie Preskitt of Everett, Washington and "Lariat of Dreams" choreographed by DFW area's JL and Linda Pelton of Dallas, Texas.
