This event has four excellent callers and I will be the cuer. Let me share a bit of information about the callers.


- Darryl is a nationally renowned caller whose choreography, timing and smoothness are legendary;
   and he should be well known to metroplex dancers.
- Tim should be well known to most of us since he's frequently in D/FW for specials. He brings a high level of entertainment value to all his dances.
- Jeff is an OKC area caller who is widening the area where he calls and calls a lot throughout the Heartland. Great voice, music selection, timing. etc.
- Calvin may be known to a few of you since he guest called with Wayne at one of our dances. He has a great voice, terrific timing, and brings instant enthusiasm to a dance.

The venue is in Elk City, OK West of OKC. Host hotel has a \$45 room rate. For those who camp there is RV camping on site with water and electric for \$20 a night. A campground is also near the host hotel.

The primary dance level will be mainstream with plus tips. Also there will be two sessions featuring A2 level. I will even have an intro to round dance session after lunch.
