Saturday, August 22 Tri-City Promenaders Beat the Heat Dance

6 Swinging Stars visited the Tri-City Promenaders' Saturday evening in Hurst, TX. Rounds were cued by Chris Farabaugh while squares were called by hall-of-fame club caller, Paul Kinsey. Chris cued a nice variety of songs covering many different rhythms and difficulties, and also included a brief "teach" to introduce a few common 2-step sequences to anyone willing to try them. Paul warmed square dancers up with a workshop that focused on C-2's "Crazy Concept" wherein common calls, like Circulate or Right-and-Left Through, are extended to 3 parts: 1st (as in split calls) each group of 4 does the call simultaneously and independently, 2nd the center 4 only do the call, and 3rd each group of 4 repeats the call simultaneously one final time. Specifically, Paul drilled us on "Crazy Circulate" and "Crazy Right-and-Left Through." Even beyond the workshop, Paul kept square dancers on their toes all evening long. Given the warm fellowship, great dancing, good food, and door prizes, all present had a terrific time. Swinging Stars in attendance were Bondis, Esteps, and Sees. Thank you to Jim Bondi for this report.
