Lessons started last Tuesday at Carpenter Rec Center in Plano. We had a disappointing turnout with just 3 couples, but a 4th couple had paid and called Jan to say the husband was sick but they planned on being at the next lesson. We need 4 more couples for this class to make. Please encourage your friends, neighbors, coworkers or fellow church members to come. This is the last free lesson. If we do not get those 4 additional couples, the class will not make.

To clarify what has been transpiring with Carpenter Rec Center, they are fixated on the fact that we have angels in the class and perceive our angels have been receiving free lessons. We have asked to move from Tuesdays to avoid the conflict with square dance lessons, but we are not yet sure what day we will have for class. We will update the club as soon as we have more information.

Do's and Don'ts of Square Dancing

In our opening president's message, I vented about how many people left our dance early. This is Article IX from the above:

IX. Be on time and don't leave early. In square dancing, one late couple or person may mean that three other couples or seven people must sit out. By leaving early, you are telling the other dancers and caller that you did not have a good time at the dance. The "wind-down" tip is just as important as the first or middle tips. Plan to spend the complete evening when you come.

Let's show our caller and cuer the respect they deserve by staying for the entire dance.

How to Improve your Square Dancing

Once a month, our caller, Wayne Baldwin leads the club in a mainstream workshop. Many other clubs also host workshops prior to their dance. We are always saying to improve your dancing, you need to dance. Practice your dance moves through the workshops and through visitations. The more you dance, the more you will improve.
