PRESIDENTIAL RAMBLINGS

One of the most exciting activities a club can do is to have lessons for new students. We all love to watch them learn and develop as new dancers. Of course, the purpose of lessons is to bring other potential dancers into the "sport" that we all enjoy and get them to the point that they have covered all of the mainstream calls and are ready to join the club. This allows us to grow and refresh as a club. It is great to see the excitement of new dancers!

It would probably be easier for the caller to complete a set of lessons without "help" but here are a few of the reasons that "angels" are an important component of lessons for any club.

- A club is defined by its members and as such we are the ambassadors for Swinging Stars. Most of us love meeting new people and almost all of us do not like being thrown into a situation where we are the "newbies." Thus, the better job we do at getting to know each student, the better the odds are that they will integrate nicely into the club. We need to invite the others to come but it will be best for them to come in small numbers so that we can give them personal attention and keep our normal activities as normal as possible.

Bottom line, Angels are critical to successful lessons which lead to club membership when they make that bigstep from classes-to-dances. We appreciate all of your help and look forward to seeing you on Tuesday nights whenever possible.
