### Round-Up 2022 Featured Caller

# Bobby & Dalaina Willis Lawton, Oklahoma



Bobby learned to square dance in Oklahoma at the age of 13 and fell in love with the hobby learning mainstream, plus, and advanced dancing. In 1999 he expressed an interest in calling. Henry Israel, a well-known Oklahoma caller let him do a singing call at a dance. Because Bobby showed talent, Henry took him under his wing and taught him to be a square dance caller. Calling at one of his first dances club members played a prank on him by having a local police officer put him in hand cuffs stating he was being arrested for impersonating a square dance caller. Bobby didn't get upset because he loves when dancers have fun even if it is at his expense.

He joined the Oklahoma State Caller's Association and Central District Caller's Association and served as Presi-

dent and Caller Coordinator for both organizations several times. He was hired as club caller for the Teacup Chains in Edmond, Oklahoma. He held this position for 11 years, until his employer relocated him to the Dallas area.

Bobby joined NTCA in 2012 and served as President in 2017 and 2018. He served as club caller for Trail Blazers and Solitaires in Texas while still calling for Yellow Rockers in Sulphur, Oklahoma. He called for various clubs throughout the NORTEX area. He called three years for the Swinging Stars, before returning to Oklahoma. He is currently club caller for Levis and Lace in Wichita Falls, Texas and does guest calling at many Oklahoma clubs, anniversary dances, and festivals.

Bobby has been the featured caller on numerous square dance cruises including one to the Bahamas where he coordinated with the Parliament to allow an exhibition of about 100 dancers to be conducted in Rawson Square, something that had never been allowed before. He has called club anniversaries, exhibitions, parades, and district and state festivals. He has also conducted many sets of lessons, teaching hundreds of people to dance.

Bobby met his wife, Dalaina, while she was taking square dance lessons he conducted in Hydro, Oklahoma. They have been married for 10 years. They have a son named Ayden who has already called at many dances with his father. Dalaina supports Bobby in every aspect of Square Dance; calling, serving on boards, coordinating square dance cruises, scheduling events and dancing; as often as possible.

Bobby and Dalaina have four grown children that live in Oklahoma; James, Christopher, Abbagail and Annabelle.

Bobby's love for the square dance hobby continues both as a caller and dancer with his only goal to assure dancers have as much fun as he does.

### Ray & Linda Savell North Richland Hills, Texas



After graduating from Del City High School, Oklahoma in 1972, Ray joined the Air Force and was stationed in Lubbock, Texas when he was first introduced into the wonderful world of square dancing. After being transferred to Bentwaters, England in 1975, Ray joined a British-American Square Dance club, the Swinging Eights where he danced for several years. After leaving the Air Force in 1981, Ray settled in Springtown, Texas and joined the Springtown Revolvers Square Dance Club. While dancing with his club, Ray was encouraged by several dancers to do a singing call and the rest is history! He joined the North Texas Callers Association in 1983 after attending the Square-M-Callers School. He also attended the Frank Lane Callers College in Estes Park, Colorado in 1984. Ray spent the next several years calling for multiple clubs in the North Texas area and also called for several years at Fun Valley in Colorado. Ray began calling at the Community House in Red River, New Mexico in 2010 and has

continued calling there every summer since. Ray has also co-hosted several square dance cruises.

Ray and Linda met while singing in their church choir and after performing duets together, their love for music and each other was undeniable! They began performing at several opries in the North Texas area including the well-known "Johnnie High's Country Music Revue" in Arlington. Trying to juggle both the opry performances and square dance calling became difficult so something had to give and luckily, the calling won out! In an effort to keep the duets alive, when not dancing, Linda often joins Ray on stage and adds harmony to his singing calls. This country duo loves to carry the message of the lyrics in a way that makes the songs live and your feet want to get up and dance.

With almost 40 years' experience as a caller, Ray has become widely recognized for his dedication to square dancing, not only through his calling but through his strength as a teacher and instructor. Ray continually promotes the activity by teaching lessons and his commitment to student success and his encouragement of new dancers is evident. Ray is currently the club caller for the Circle I Square Dance Club in Irving, Texas, and the Tri-City Promenaders Square Dance Club in Hurst, Texas. He also guest calls for several other clubs throughout the North Texas area. Ray has called in Louisiana, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Colorado and the Bahamas!

Chris started square dance lessons in 1997. Upon completing the first set of Basic lessons he joined the Solitaires Square and Round Dance Club. The following year, 1998, he served as president of the club and enjoyed dancing and working with club members planning various events and activities.

At this time, he also became very interested in Round Dancing and became consumed with taking any and all lessons that were offered, no matter where they were offered in the metroplex. ### 'She's a legend': After 50 years at same school, North Texas teacher begins final year

MacArthur Latin teacher Ann Price Ouzts will retire in June. Author: Sean Giggy Published: 8:45 am CDT August 31, 2022 Updated: 9:09 am CDT August 31, 2022

IRVING, Texas—MacArthur High School has been around 57 years and one woman has been around for almost all of them.

'She's a legend," said Laci Maestas, a former student and now a MacArthur art teacher.

"She's the oldest person I know," said sophomore Charisa Hongwises. "My grandmother is in her 70s, so it's like, "Wow."

83-year-old Latin teacher Ann Price Ouzts—the kids just call her Miss Price—started at MacArthur in 1969

This is her 57th year teaching overall and 50th at MacArthur and it's also her last.

She's retiring in June. Although, she already tried to retire once and was back within two years.

"They needed me and I'll never regret it," Price said. "It was a wonderful decision."

She says she first made the decision to be a teacher when she was just two years old.

"I would come home and teach my dolls everything I learned that day." she said.

By the time she got to college, she noticed a lot of students in her history and English classes and knew the job market would soon be flooded with history and English teachers.

"I knew that I would never find a job," Price said.

Because there were only a handful of students in her Latin class, she settled on her career path and has loved every minute since.

Over the years, a lot has changed, especially her hairstyles, a change evident by browsing the school's yearbooks. However, Price says reaching students has always been the same.

"Relationships are everything," Price said.

"I think her students are better for it to be able to get an opportunity to not just learn from her but to get an opportunity for her to pour into them," said MacArthur principal Natasha Stewart.

The same way she poured in to one student who got sick, by having the entire class sign a get well soon card.

"She dropped it by the house," said Jeff Tillerson, the student who received that card back in 1987.

"That's the kind of person Miss Price is. She cares about her students and makes you feel wanted in her classroom."

He's now the second longest tenured teacher at MacArthur, 20 years behind Price.

He'll be the old man on campus the day she retires, a day she is dreading.

"I just don't want to quit," Price said as she held back tears.

She clearly loves the job. Loves it so much, she's already contemplating coming out of retirement. Again.

"Maybe if Miss Stewart, our principal wants to continue Latin, I might consider it," said Price.

"We'll welcome her to do whatever she wants to," Stewart said. "Even it if's to walk the hallways and prance around showing her cute outfit."

That's how you go out in style.

#### Demo Dancer Dangle Rules

9/7/2022

**Introduction:** The Demo Dancer Dangle is a means of showing appreciation to those dancers that help to promote our pastime by making themselves available for demo dances.

**Participants:** After the first demo a dangle will be given along with a signature card for future demos. The number of demos will be noted in increments of 5 with a teardrop attached showing the total number of Demo Dances the dancer has participated in.

#### **Rules:**

- Demo Dances must be reported to the Promotion & Demo Chair by the organizer of the demo.
  - Organizer will give the Promotion & Demo Chair
    - Date of demo
    - Location of demo
    - List of participants
    - Picture of the group (if available)
  - If there are multiple dances on the same day, the dancer gets credit for each dance.
    - Example: Flash Mob Dances at multiple locations would result in the dancer getting credit for a Demo Dance at each location.
- Participants will be responsible to:
  - Have their Demo Dance signature card signed by the Demo Organizer
    - Must include date and location of each demo listed
  - Turn completed cards in to the Promotion & Demo Chair
- The Promotion & Demo Chair
  - Will process the participant's signature card and determine the teardrop they are qualified to receive
  - Will deliver the dangle or teardrop to the Area VP or Club President
- The Area VP or Club President
  - Will deliver the dangle or teardrop to the dancer
  - The Area VP or Club President may request the awards be delivered directly to the dancer.
    - These instructions could be a standing request and not repeated with each new delivery
