Message from the PresidentsRichard and Jan Covington

No rest for the weary... Your club president logged a lot of hours Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday getting ready for a Friday night dance, a Saturday Board Meeting and reviewing future dates and contracts for callers & cuers. I know what you're thinking...he prepares????, yes Virginia, I prepare my thoughts for the announcements right up until time to give them - haha. It is time well spent.

We have a spreadsheet of dates of our dances that tracks when our callers and cuers will not be in with us it also tracks the guest callers/cuers filling and when/whether they have signed a contract. We have most of 2025 completed and we started 2026. Communications have gone to Charlie & Kristy Robertson and Jan & David Tom asking they the confirm their dates. The spreadsheet is constantly updated with new and/or revised information. Even with all-of this tracking, you may recall, we had one dance where we missed a date and David Toms stepped in and called for us. It is good to have a talented caller willing and able to step-in at the last moment. Also, we ask David to substitute for Charlie often when he is out. As you know, David not only calls for us he and Jan have taught our square dance classes for the past several years. Thanks again David & Jan for all you do...

Your board periodically looks at ways to possible improve our Club. Saturday was a long but productive board meeting. We discussed our 2025 Pre-Round Up dance date as to whether is should be the second or fourth Friday dance and the two dates in question were September 26th or October 10th of 2025. There are definite positives for both. The fourth Friday, 09/26/2025 won the split decision. However, Charlie will not be available to call 09/26/2025 Pre-Round Up dance and we will need a guest caller. We discussed potential callers for our 09/26/2025 Pre-Round Up dance. Charlie will be calling our regular club dance, 10/10/2025.

We discussed whether to have lessons in the coming winter/spring due to the cost. Since NORTEX only allows one lessons grant per year per club a lot of the burden of the second set of lessons will fall on the club. It was decided that we would plan lessons to start in February 2025 rather than January. It also decided that we will continue to offer lessons on Tuesday at Network Ministries and that the caller would be paid based on a percentage of each student's tuition. For example, we pay \$40 per night for lessons based on eight students, however, if there are only six students and the decision is made to have lessons, then 6/8th of \$40 would be reduced the caller's pay to \$30 per night. Of course, the caller will have a say as to whether to proceed with lessons based on the number of students

David Toms is already obligated to teach Kissin' Kuzzins on Tuesday's nights in January. The board asked me to teach and I am available, honored, and willing to teach. I have taught five complete sets of mainstream lessons, and I have taught a lot of Plus and Advanced classes.

We hope to have another demo for Network Ministries the Thursday before our lessons start to encourage attendees to take lessons start in February 2025. We also discussed reaching out to the sponsor churches and offer to give demos or square dance parties for their empty nester's groups. This is a longer-range plan for classes starting next September. I'll reach out to Network Ministries in to set up the Demo for their Senior's group.

Given the pool of active members, approximately eighteen, it was discussed eliminating the office 1st VP position and having President, VP, Secretary and Treasurer. It was pointed out that NORTEX only requires member clubs to have a President, Secretary and Treasurer. The board currently consist of five offices, and these are filled by five couples. Though it does not have to be a couple but most often in our club it has been. That is ten of the eighteen active members and not all eighteen members are willing and able to serve on the board. After discussing in detail, the reassignment 1st VP duties and putting most of the duties on committee members, the discussion was tabled for further review and how the bylaws would need to be rewritten to make the change. However, if we do not have a candidate/nominee the position could remain open. As of today, we do not have a willing candidate though I have not yet talked to everyone. If you are willing and able to fill the role of 1st VP, please reach out to me. Thank you, guys, for stepping up to take a position on the board. Your service and commitment to Swinging Stars is appreciated.

On a very positive note, Charlie & Kristi's contract has been signed for 01/01/2025 – 12/31/2025 and the board will offer Jan to extend her current contract, (07/01/2024 – 06/30/2025) to expire 12/31/2025 to get the caller/cuer contracts concurrent.

We discussed various other issues including whether to have a substitute cuer on those dates that Jan is not available. We decided that we need to capture information about the round dancer attendance on the date she is not cueing and whether it is a second or fourth Friday. Neven indicated he could make a note of it. We will revisit it later.

To Christmas-party or not to Christmas-party, that is the question.... For the past several years, Nina Lassiter has graciously opened her beautiful home to us for our party. This year she is going to be out of town for Christmas. We discussed alternate locations including the Elk's Lodge in Plano. Chris Trujillo and Linda Harris are working to come up with a viable solution.... If you are willing to host the Christmas party, reach out to Linda or Chris. Stay tuned to your favorite newsletter for more information.

We decided to forgo having a guest caller for the anniversary dance. We all love Charlie and Kristi Robertson and the great job they do. Jan and David Toms continue to do a fabulous job on the rounds. The anniversary dance is on a fifth Friday, 05/30/2025 and thus will go dark on the fourth Friday, 05/23/2025.

We discussed and agreed to have a "Student Dance" on 12/13/2024 and invite other clubs to bring their students. Everyone will have come near the completion of lessons and should be able to dance a good list of calls. We will advertise at least one tip for Student Dancers. Charlie assured me tonight at the Circle I dance that he can call an interesting and challenging dance using the list of calls the student have completed. We will need to confirm what calls other clubs, planning to attend, have taught. Also, our sixteenth lesson and graduation is planned be at our January 10, 2025 dance and it will be our advertised "New Dancer" Dance.

Put 11/10/2024 at 4:00 PM on your calendar for our club members meeting and officer elections.

We had 70 dancers for our double deal dance with Dan Nordbye. This included 18 Swinging Stars members. We had eleven Circle I, eleven Rebel Rousers and ten Kissin' Kuzzins and eight Reelers. David and Dan shared a tip they only practiced through email.... They were great together.

It was good to see Harry and Zari Kilejian on the dance floor again. They have been angeling our lessons for the past couple of weeks. They did great. Give them a big Yellow-Rock when you see them.

We had a very good contingency of Swinging Stars to make it over to Circle I's Pre-Round Up dance. Charlie Robertson and Ray Savel did a bang-up job of delivering a fast-paced dance with creative figures. Charlie called "everybody cross run" from two-faced lines and "swing-thru" from left-handed waves (it starts in the middle rather than the ends). Chris Farabaugh delivered his smooth round dances to the enjoyment of all round dancers.

It has been a great week for square dancing, and we look forward to the upcoming dances leading to Callers Cavalcade and Round Up. Have you bought your tickets? What are you waiting for?
