Message from the PresidentsRichard and Jan Covington

In this month's Promenade, Audrey Mansell, President of NORTEX, stated "There is a joy of dancing that has not been seen in years". I agree there is an excitement growing and we are seeing more folks getting involved plus it seems more students are taking lessons. Our club dance was certainly exciting. Charlie and Kristi were caught in traffic and David Toms started the dance by calling very good first square dance tip. Jan Toms wowed the round dancers with her fabulous cueing and song selection. Charlie and Kristi arrived with a ball-of-fire and the excitement continued. We had forty visitors with notable attendance from Triangle Squares (13), Rebel Rousers (11) and Pegasus with (8). We had 30 Swinging Stars for a total of 70. Thank you all for coming and keeping it lively.

We all need to do all we can to promote our activity. Your involvement in doing this is vital. Talk about it on your Social Media Platforms, post pictures, video, etc. like you are talking to your best square dance friend. Tell everyone you meet about the fun you had at the weekend dance you just attended, tell them about the excitement you have for the upcoming dances and how much fun you had with helping with lessons.

I have to tell you; it has been a busy week starting with our quarterly NORTEX meeting. Before I get into the details, I want to let you know that your NORTEX representatives are Jan and I, Dave and Lorraine Burson and John and Debbie Cave. We all have the improvement and advancement of square and round dancing in our hearts. And, as your representatives we have the best interest of Swinging Stars at heart. We are open to your input.

Several important items were discussed at the NORTEX meeting including the following:

- the cost of the electronic ads in the promenade
- the nomination of new officers
- the upcoming 75th National Square and Round Dance Convention to be held in Waco, TX in June 2026
- the letter from the Texas Federation of Square and Round Dance and whether we should accept their offer to affiliate

What's this all about? You may not be aware but years ago NORTEX was a part of the Texas Federation of Square and Round Dance organization. There was a difference in opinion, as presented from the floor at the meeting, that it was due to the voting procedures as each area organization only had three votes regardless of membership size. Thus, the small area associations had the same number of votes as the larger area associations. For example, an association of 50 had the same number of votes as an association of 500 members. Kevin Hadley indicated that in 2011 as president of NORTEX he and the then president of the Texas State Federation started

having communications to improve the relationship between our two organizations. The efforts in that regard have continued with subsequent presidents and board members.

In the attached letter, you will note that they have offered NORTEX the opportunity to become an Affiliated Member of the Texas State Federation organization. As an Affiliated Member we would not pay them dues or share in their Teen Scholarship Program nor participate in their insurance program. As an Affiliate Member we would have an open invitation to attend general business meetings and to speak at their meetings with the recognition of the chair of the meeting. They would keep us informed of activities of TSFSRD with the invitation to participate. Subject to scheduling, they would list our Roundup as a visitation for officers and past presidents.

A number of other issues were discussed, and it was suggested that if we accept their offer, we should extend the same Affiliation status to TSFSRD.

An issue involving your NTCA was brought up by the NTCA Secretary, Jack Von der Hyde, that needs to be clarified regarding the proposed affiliation with the state federation, will NTCA callers be able to call for state functions? Currently it is not possible as the callers for state functions have to be nominated by two or more area organizations before they are considered. It is my understanding, that since NORTEX is not a member of the Texas State Federation, it is not possible for NORTEX to nominate callers for state functions. So, if we affiliate, will NORTEX be able to nominate callers for state functions?

In regard to the cost of ads in the electronic Promenade, the Directors studied the situation and Kevin Hadley presented their findings. Their finding was that the current cost of electronic ads was justified as there are addition modifications and editorial changes required before publishing the Promenade.

Moving on, Liberty Recreation Center is where we are holding, and have held, our lessons. They have had some issues with angels coming and going with no accounting for them. Like every organization they have insurance and legal issues to adhere to. So, Linda Harris, First VP and Chair of Lessons and I met with Precious Scott and Kristi Bell of Liberty Recreation Center to discuss possible solutions. The best solution was decided upon, and it is that Liberty Recreation Center will establish a concurrent class where the angels will register at no charge. The class will be labeled Angels or Square Dance Angels. This should be on the Liberty Recreation Center's website before Monday's class. We will all need to register in order to keep using their facility.

We also discussed that our instructor's back -up needs to have a background check done prior to teaching a class. Since Jan and I have covered for David and Jan Toms in the past, Jan and I completed the Background Check forms. Other teacher that sub will need to complete the background form prior to teaching. There is no charge for the background check.

In order to hold our room and time slot David plans to hold a polishing fun shop to continue to review the mainstream calls. This will be open to any and all dancers that wants that want work on improving their mainstream dancing ability. It will be in a square dance format. The center has day passes for those attending classes. Day passes are \$10 per person. It may be cheaper to sign up for the class and pre-pay. Also, we may need a core group of eight for the class to make... they weren't clear on that, but she mentioned that she can't show a loss for the use of the room.
