Message from the Presidents Richard and Jan Covington

Your board will be meeting today, Sunday, to discuss upcoming dances, student graduation and to continue to plan our future lessons and conduct business of the club.

Do you take the American Square Dance magazine? It has been around for years and Buddy Weaver, a Nationally well know Caller, purchased the magazine and is offering an annual subscription for \$17. That's a great bargain for dancers interested in things going on in our favorite activity. They have very interesting articles. The web-site where you can subscribe is https://www.americansquaredance.com/

Here is an excerpt from the most recent edition.... "The fundamental purpose of an SSD-like program: Teaching shorter and simpler classes more frequently results in markedly higher growth for clubs."

As a club I know many of us have not been interested in SSD (an abbreviated Mainstream list). However, it seems that it is something that we must now consider.... "We keep doing the same things over-and-over but we expect different results..." it has been said that this is the definition of insanity.

You would be surprised to know that many of the top callers in DFW have been calling SSD (plus spin-the-top) for two-to-three years now. Those clubs where the caller calls SSD and don't advertise SSD are much more fun, don't you agree. Maybe it's all about perception. We all know that Deborah Carroll Jones has been teaching SSD and she calls a very interesting & fun dance. Ray Savel calls an excellent dance using the SSD list and there are more.

The Proposal by the Board of Governors at Callerlab this year was to the combine Basic 1, Basic 2 and part of the Mainstream Programs and to call it Mainstream. The new Mainstream list would be limited to no more than 50 calls. The remaining calls would be moved into the Plus Program making it a list of no more than 60 calls. Note, there are roughly 110 calls on the combined B1, B2, MS and Plus list now. Thus, the total number will not change up thru the Plus Program. The callers are taking the next eleven months to think and talk about it. It will come to a vote at our 2025 Callerlab Convention and at least another year to determine what calls will make what list and then a third year for clubs to adopt it. Thus, the new Mainstream list is not yet determined and will not be available for a couple of years, I believe we as Swinging Stars don't have that long to wait before adopting a modified list such as SSD. We need to move much quicker… like by our September lessons.

I have opposed the SSD program but after watching things in the square dance world continue to decline, I believe we need to reconsider this as a viable option. Ten years ago, we were a club of 135 members, and we didn't see the need for change. Today we are at 23.

For the current B1, B2 and MS list Callerlab recommends 24 weeks to teach and learn it - that's six months. We have been teaching it in 16 weeks as that is what students will commit to timewise. As a result, and at no fault of the students or the callers, we are introducing them under-prepared to the dance floor and it is frustrating for the new dancers. We see a smaller number join and within a year, those that join either take lessons again or quit. Teaching and dancing the shorter list will better fit the 16-week class schedule. Also, we need at least two, if not three, lessons per year.

That brings us to another issue. Our 1st VPs are responsible for lessons and somehow that became translated to them attending every lesson. Running lessons is not hard as all that is needed is someone to set out the sign-in sheets and layout the students name tags. We added one additional duty and that is to take a copy of the Angel sign-in list by the front desk so they can make a copy. Going forward the 1st VPs will provide a duty-roster sign-up sheet to those willing to be Lesson's Liaison for the evening. We can rotate this duty from week-to-week between the angels and thereby relieve the dreaded obligation of being at lessons every week. We have a core group of angels that are there almost every week anyway so dividing this duty should not be a problem.

We will discuss whether to adopt the SSD list and multiple lessons at our May 19th Club Meeting. Think about it and be there.

Peggy Amy has stepped up and agreed to head our officer nominations and John and Debbie Cave have agreed to serve on the committee. There is room for a couple more people, if you would like to serve. This is a mid-year affirmation of our current officers and our current board plans to return, so the work should be limited. If you had rather sit on the board, you can nominate yourself. Either way you can contact me or Peggy directly.

Jan and I will miss our next Swinging Stars Dance, April 12th. We know that it will be a great one. We will be back for our second April Dance on April 26th. Also, we and the Caves will miss our 04/21 NORTEX meeting. We appreciate Chris & Merry Trujillo and Neven Mulvin for agreeing to be our substitute delegates. This is an important meeting as new NORTEX officers will be elected and a vote will be made as to whether to be an affiliate member of the Texas State Federation.

Speaking of our anniversary dance, look around... we have become a small club. So... every member is needed, and every member will need to sign up for multiple activities. We have signed up to bring a cake, help with set up, help with decorating, greet our visitors, serve cake plus our normal presidential dance responsibilities. I know we are not alone as others have already signed up to help with multiple tasks. Thank you all for all you do to make Swinging Stars the best we can be.
