Message from the Presidents Richard and Jan Covington

I am sure you all remember, Square dancing used to be a great family activity. It still is but to my knowledge, we/SS don't currently have any family units we have had them in the past; most recently we had Peggy Amy's daughter, granddaughter and grand-son-in-law. In the sixties, seventies and eighties square dancing had a lot of family units. Parents brought their kids to lessons with them. So their children learned at early ages and continued through adulthood. We need to restart the trend. It would be great to provide baby sitting to young parents.

Of course, our callers are always available to help in any way we can. If someone wanted private lessons for a group of at least eight people (such as a family unit or a group of friends) we can make it happen. We'll work around their schedule. It takes about 16 weeks with one two hour lesson per week. However, this can be condensed. Some have found success giving 8 weeks of lessons with four hour lessons on Saturday.

Email from Bob Estep:

Arrived back in TX on June 1 with broken right shoulder and a broken left hip. The rehab center I was in is excellent and they got me on my feet and walking (With help of course). This past Monday they transferred me to Encompass Rehabilitation Hospital so I can receive more PT than the first facility is staffed to provide. I now receive a minimum of three hours of PT every day. Game plan is another week here and if I do well, I may get to go home this weekend. With a walker and a wheelchair. The unknown is the right arm/shoulder. I still am not allowed to use any other weight in using it. Hope to see everyone again before too long.
