Message from the PresidentsRichard and Jan Covington

Happy National Square Dance Month!!! Yes, September is National Square Dance Month.

Square dance lessons are starting for a lot of clubs this month. Our lessons started Tuesday, and we have seven paid female students and a couple more folks considering it. Unless we get some male students, we will need lots of male angels or female angels that can dance the male part. We have three young ladies ages late teens to early twenties. That is so exciting.

In September's American Square Dancer, Buddy Weaver writes that square dance "lessons" is relatively a new thing as "lessons" did not start till the very late 1940's. Prior to that time, square dancing was only a part of an evening of folk dancing. If the caller wanted to call to a specific tune, he would teach the dance pattern in its entirety so that everyone could participate. Obviously, those that already knew the routine of the song did not want to continuing learning it again-and-again. Thus, the idea was to form a class of six weeks to teach the songs routines. (Wayne Baldwin told me when he started calling that he taught the pattern for the song he wanted to sing.) Buddy continued, the dancers who completed the class would be invited to join one or more groups where they would simply dance... in time, learning dances was replaced by learning calls that made up the dance. The number of frequent calls increased, and the list grew. It wasn't long till "lessons" became an annual event. Most started in September to coincide with the kids returning to school giving the parents freedom to go to square dance lessons.

In the 1960's (and early 70's) there was a movement to name September as National Square Dance Month and that solidified September as the annual start of class. Even today many clubs start lessons in September. (Paraphrase from Buddy Weaver's Sept 2024 article in the American Square Dancer).

Here's food for thought, how many dances could they teach in six weeks, six-ten maybe, and how many calls would that encompass? A singing call has 7-10 calls, and some calls are used in almost every song such as square through, left allemande, weave the ring and promenade. So, a rough estimate would be 35 calls were learned and used in the process of six lessons and ten songs. Point being, it's does not take a large-number-of calls to enjoy the fun of square dancing.

The demo for Network Ministries is Thursday, 09/19/2024. We need one more couple to make a square. Dave and Lorraine Burson & Charlie and Linda Harris & Jan Covington and Peggy Amy have indicated they will be there. We need everyone that can to be there and gather at 10:30 for the 10:45 demo. I plan to call the demo and the dress is casual. This demo is in exchange for half of one Month's rent, \$150. We don't normally charge for demos, so this is extra special. As usual Jan Toms and Charlie Robertson gave us a great dance. We had six-to-eight round dance couples dancing and we had four squares dancing with several dancers sitting out and our plus tips had four squares. Total dancers we had forty-four, two students (Patricia Wright and Swetei Mistry) and we had four non-dance visitors one of whom danced tandem with Gene Geyer during the student tip. So, there was a total of 49 at our dance including the Swetei, her family and one visitor from David's work. Swetei also works with David.

Our thanks to Rebel Rousers (13), Circle I (5), Tri-City Promenaders (2), Plus Squares (1) and five independent dancers for coming and making our Sock Hop Dance Special.
